**Vehicle removed from verge – Shackle St**

On a request at the October meeting, a vehicle which had been parked for some months on the verge has now been removed after an approach from Council inspectors.

**Graffiti again during the month.**

Unfortunately we were severely hit with graffiti towards the end of October with damage to the shops, toilet block, 'lizard' sign and seating. Most of it has now been removed. I have some graffiti remover which I have used on the benches to good effect if someone needs to borrow it

**Suburban nature strip pruning**

Council advise that pruning will commence in Anula on 30 October.

**Marrara Sports Complex footpath**

Work is continuing on the 3m footpath within the complex which will eventually go all the way around – providing a safe environment for pedestrians. It is also a very popular jogging/walking track in the late afternoon.

**Petition against footpath on Carnoustie Circuit, Northlakes**

Council has received a petition from some residents objecting to Council placing a 1.2m concrete footpath. Other residents want the footpath. The Ward aldermen will conduct a public meeting during November.
